
EASTER EGGCITEMENT!

SPENDING UPDATE

In previous newsletters, we had announced that we had purchased a new stage for the school costing around £5,000, Unfortunately, when the stage was delivered it was found to be incomplete, and parts were not matching. When we contacted the company, we were told that they were unable to provide the staging as pictured on their site.

As such, we arranged for them to collect the staging and we received a full refund, When we enquired with the company who made the staging, we were informed that for them to provide us with the exact staging we were after, would cost an extra £4,000 bring the total cost of the staging to around £9,000.

A CHANGE OF PLAN

Having discussed this with Mr Daniels, we have decided that instead of the stage. providing money for a new piece of play equipment on the playground should take priority. We know how popular the current equipment is with the children, but it is clear to everyone how tired it looks and desperately needs replacing.

ALL TO PLAY FOR

As such, we have decided that the money from the staging should instead go towards provided a new piece of play equipment, alongside any money raised from events held in the Spring and Summer term.

This equipment will look to fill the current space occupied by the play equipment.

We are currently looking at prices from companies, but we believe the removal of the equipment and current flooring and the installation of new equipment and flooring will cost in the region of £28,000. The school has some money available to go towards this and as such we are looking to raise around £10,000. Your help in raising this amount, so that we can have the new equipment installed and ready to go for the new school year, would be much appreciated.

Please contact myself or Katie if you, or a company you work for, could help us in providing this much need piece of play equipment.
